### 1. Church is back next week!

After 13 weeks of church at home, everyone is welcome to join us at St David's at 8:30am next Sunday, 12 July, for a Combined Service.

- For the first month or so we will continue with a combined service at 8:30am and assess how it is working in the current COVID-19 environment. No permanent decisions have been made about service times and constructive feedback will be appreciated.

## CHURCH NEXT WEEK—12 JULY

Everybody is welcome to join us next Sunday at 8:30am at St David's for church.

As mentioned in previous weeks, we're taking the safety of each one of you very seriously so we can't simply return to how things were prior to lockdown.

#### What to expect:

- you are asked to stay home if feeling unwell and watch via the live-streaming
- a roll will be taken each week for contact tracing purposes
- hands must be sanitized before entering. Hand sanitizer will be available
- social distancing must be maintained and you will need to sit 1.5m apart, with those from the same households able to sit together. The church seating has been arranged to accommodate this. Please do not move the seats around.
- no moving around the church is permitted
- for Holy Communion, an individual cup will be available on your way in and this will be filled as you remain where you're seated when the bread is distributed
- offertory collection will be retiring
- all kids to sit with their families. The chapel is unavailable. No Sunday School but activity sheets will be provided
- seats will be available in the breezeway and under the marquee should the church seating be fully utilized
- morning tea will be supplied in individual portions and disposable cups used
- a deep clean of the church will be performed after the service

# SUNDAY HOME SERVICE

*Based on A Service of Praise, Prayer and Proclamation from the Prayer Book (p.34)*

## 1. Opening Scriptures (read aloud):

Great and marvellous are your deeds,  
Lord God Almighty.  
Just and true are your ways,  
King of the nations.  
Who will not fear you, Lord,  
and bring glory to your name?  
For you alone are holy.  
All nations will come  
and worship before you,  
for your righteous acts have been revealed.

Revelation 15:3-4

## 2. Prayers (read aloud)

Almighty God, your Son Jesus Christ has taught us that what we do for the least of his brothers and sisters we do also for him: give us the will to serve others as he was the servant of all, who gave up his life and died for us; yet lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.. Amen.

Thank you, Father, for making yourself known to us and showing the way of salvation through faith in your Son. We ask you now to teach and encourage us through your word, so that we may be ready to serve you; for the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

## 3. Read Genesis 24:34-49, 58-67 aloud

Read Romans 7:14-25 aloud

Read Matthew 11:15-30 aloud

## 4. Reflection

Spend a few minutes reflecting on your own 'battle within', your struggle with sin. It affects us all so reflect on how we can encourage one another to stand firm and also remind ourselves that we stand forgiven.

## 5. Read Matt's reflection aloud

Spend a few minutes in silence reflecting on both your and Matt's reflections.

## 6. Prayer

Spend a few minutes praying for our world, our nation and our community in this time of great need. Then pray:

*Eternal God, shepherd and guide, in your mercy give your Church in this diocese a shepherd after your own heart who will walk in your ways, and with loving care watch over your people. Give us a leader of vision and a teacher of your truth. So may your Church be built up and your name glorified; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.*

Our Father in heaven,  
hallowed be your name,  
your kingdom come,  
your will be done on earth as in heaven.  
Give us today our daily bread.  
Forgive us our sins  
as we forgive those who sin against us.  
Save us from the time of trial  
and deliver us from evil.  
For the kingdom, the power,  
and the glory are yours,  
now and for ever. Amen.
