Agreed upon by the Archbishops, Bishops,
and the whole clergy of the Provinces of
Canterbury and York, London, 1562

Our Anglican identity is founded on the 39 Articles of Religion, which present to us a timeless and sound Biblical doctrine. Each week we'll print one here and encourage you to discuss with one another the relevance or implications of it for our church in 2020 and beyond.

11. Of the Justification of Man

We are accounted righteous before God, only for the merit of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ by Faith, and not for our own works or deservings. Wherefore, that we are justified by Faith only, is a most wholesome Doctrine, and very full of comfort, as more largely is expressed in the Homily of Justification.
