



- a roll will be taken for COVID-19 contact tracing purposes
- social distancing must be maintained and you will need to sit 1.5m apart. Those from the same household are able to sit together. The church seating has been arranged to accommodate this. Please do not move the seats around.
- no moving around the church is permitted
- for Holy Communion, an individual cup will be available on your way in and this will be filled as you remain where you are when the bread is distributed
- a retiring offertory will be available near the door
- all kids to sit with their families. The chapel is unavailable. No Sunday School but activity sheets will be provided
- seats will be available in the breezeway and under the marquee should the church seating be fully utilized
- morning tea will be available and served to you
- a deep clean of the church will be performed after the service

THE ARTICLES OF RELIGION

Agreed upon by the Archbishops, Bishops,
and the whole clergy of the Provinces of
Canterbury and York, London, 1562

We're currently exploring the 39 Anglican 'Articles of Religion' which were written in 1562 as part of the Reformation to define our beliefs and to ensure that we don't stray from the truth of God's word.

31. Of the one Oblation of Christ finished up on the Cross.

The offering of Christ once made is that perfect redemption, propitiation, and satisfaction, for all the sins of the whole world, both original and actual; and there is none other satisfaction for sin, but that alone. Wherefore the sacrifices of Masses, in the which it was commonly said, that the Priest did offer Christ for the quick and the dead, to have remission of pain or guilt, were blasphemous fables, and dangerous deceits.

What this means for us today:

Our faith in Jesus ensures that we are forgiven of all our sin. His death and resurrection was the perfect and complete sacrifice for sin, not needing to be repeated as with any Old Testament sacrifices. No church sacrament is a replacement, addition or repetition of this, but a reminder of our participation through faith and the call to be faithful disciples.

Our 2021 Parish Annual General Meeting is scheduled to be held in only 4 weeks time.
