JUN 20 - JOYFUL SERVANT (2 CORINTHIANS 6:1-13)

“Nah! I don’t want to go.
My brothers won’t starve.
Besides, they’re not fighting, just talk!”
Could you imagine David ever saying that?
He didn’t! When his Dad asked him to go, he did and the fight with Goliath became history.
David – a young man, competent, obedient, full of joy to worship God and to walk with Him. He could express this same confidence later in Psalm 9:9.

‘The Lord is a stronghold in times of trouble.
For you Lord have never forsaken those who seek you.’

David knew and tested that statement.

Paul knew it too,

‘...do not receive God’s grace in vain.’

It is God’s grace that sets us free to walk, joyfully, with Jesus as a new person. If this is true, then it’s a message to be shared, not ‘sat on’ or ‘bottled up’.

The disciples in a desperate storm wake Jesus for help. He commands both the wind and water and nature obeys his command.

They ask; ‘Who is this?’ Could they answer after some time with Jesus?

You would hope so, but tradition and local perspectives can blind us to the truth.

Jesus is Creator, sustainer, Messiah and Saviour. Being saved by Jesus is, then, sheer Joy.

Live it with him!

10. Of Free-Will

The condition of Man after the fall of Adam is such, that he cannot turn and prepare himself, by his own natural strength and good works, to faith; and calling upon God. Wherefore we have no power to do good works pleasant and acceptable to God, without the grace of God by Christ preventing us, that we may have a good will, and working with us, when we have that good will.

What this means for us today: We choose to be faithful to God because he first chose us to be his people. Our faith is a gift from God which we cannot earn for ourselves. As such, we have the freedom to BE faithful and obedient to him with thankfulness in our hearts. We have a renewed purpose in life to love, serve and please him at all times.
